As you are aware, the Township of North Brunswick is continually making improvements to the road system to better serve our residents.

We are pleased to advise the residents of Holly Lane that work on your street will soon commence. Lucas Brothers, Inc. of Morganville, NJ has been retained by the Township of North Brunswick to construct the project, and, **weather permitting**, they anticipate starting this work **on or about the week of August 4, 2008**. Construction will generally be done between 7:00 AM and 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday.

The work involved with this particular road upgrade will include work from Oak Road to the northernmost intersection of Holly Lane with Sycamore Lane, and includes underdrain installation, curb and sidewalk replacement and excavation and replacement of the roadway.

In order that the work proceed efficiently it is important that cars be kept off the street in the work area during working hours so they do not interfere with construction activities. **Any cars not removed will be towed at the Owner's expense, so please do not leave your car unattended in the work area.** Also, note that the Contractor may be storing construction equipment and materials along portions of the street. Please refrain from blocking these areas with vehicles and please keep children from playing in these areas. Your cooperation with all of these guidelines is appreciated.

Access to the street and your driveway will be limited at times due to the ongoing work. During the actual paving work, access will not be available for that day and we will provide you with a detailed notice before that work begins. We appreciate your cooperation with parking your vehicles at a location away from the work zone to avoid any interference. If this presents a particular problem, please advise us immediately.

Reminder - If your property has a sump pump system that discharges to the sanitary or storm system, please call **Mr. Jason Nizolek of CME Associates – 732-727-8000**, and advise him accordingly so that we may reconfigure the sump pump discharge to the underdrain system being installed as part of this Contract.

Every effort will be made to minimize any inconvenience during construction. The township's consulting engineer, CME Associates, will have representatives in the area while the work takes place. If you have any questions or comments, do not hesitate to approach one of these representatives or contact **Mr. Nizolek**.

Once again, thank you for your anticipated cooperation during these improvements.
