As you are aware, the Township of North Brunswick is continually making improvements to the road system to better serve our residents.

We are pleased to advise the residents of Pleasant Place and Castle Court that work on your street will soon commence. Lucas Brothers, Inc. of Morganville, NJ has been retained by the Township of North Brunswick to construct the project, and, **weather permitting**, they anticipate starting this paving work **on or about July 14, 2008**. Mobilization and minor curb work may be performed prior to that date. Construction will generally be done between 7:00 AM and 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday, and is weather dependent.

The work involved with this particular road upgrade will include selected curb repair and the removal and replacement of the asphalt surface course of the road.

In order that the work proceed efficiently it is important that cars be kept off the street in the work area during working hours so they do not interfere with construction activities. Also, note that the Contractor may be storing construction equipment and materials along portions of the street. Please refrain from blocking these areas with vehicles and please keep children from playing in these areas. Your cooperation with these guidelines is appreciated.

Any cars not removed will be towed at the Owner's expense, so please do not leave your car unattended in the street.

Access to the street and your driveway will be limited during the work. During the actual paving work, access will not be available for that day and we will provide you with a detailed notice before that work begins. We appreciate your cooperation with parking your vehicles at a location away from the work zone to avoid any interference. If this presents a particular problem, please advise us immediately.

Every effort will be made to minimize any inconvenience during construction. The Township's Consulting Engineer, CME Associates, will have a representative in the area while the work takes place.
