



**NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL AS PART OF
VEGETATION MANAGEMENT WORK**

Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) utilizes the electric transmission right-of-way through your municipality. The electric transmission lines on this right-of-way are essential for PSE&G to meet its commitment to provide safe, proper, and adequate electric service to consumers throughout New Jersey. Maintaining proper tree clearance from the transmission lines is absolutely necessary to assure:

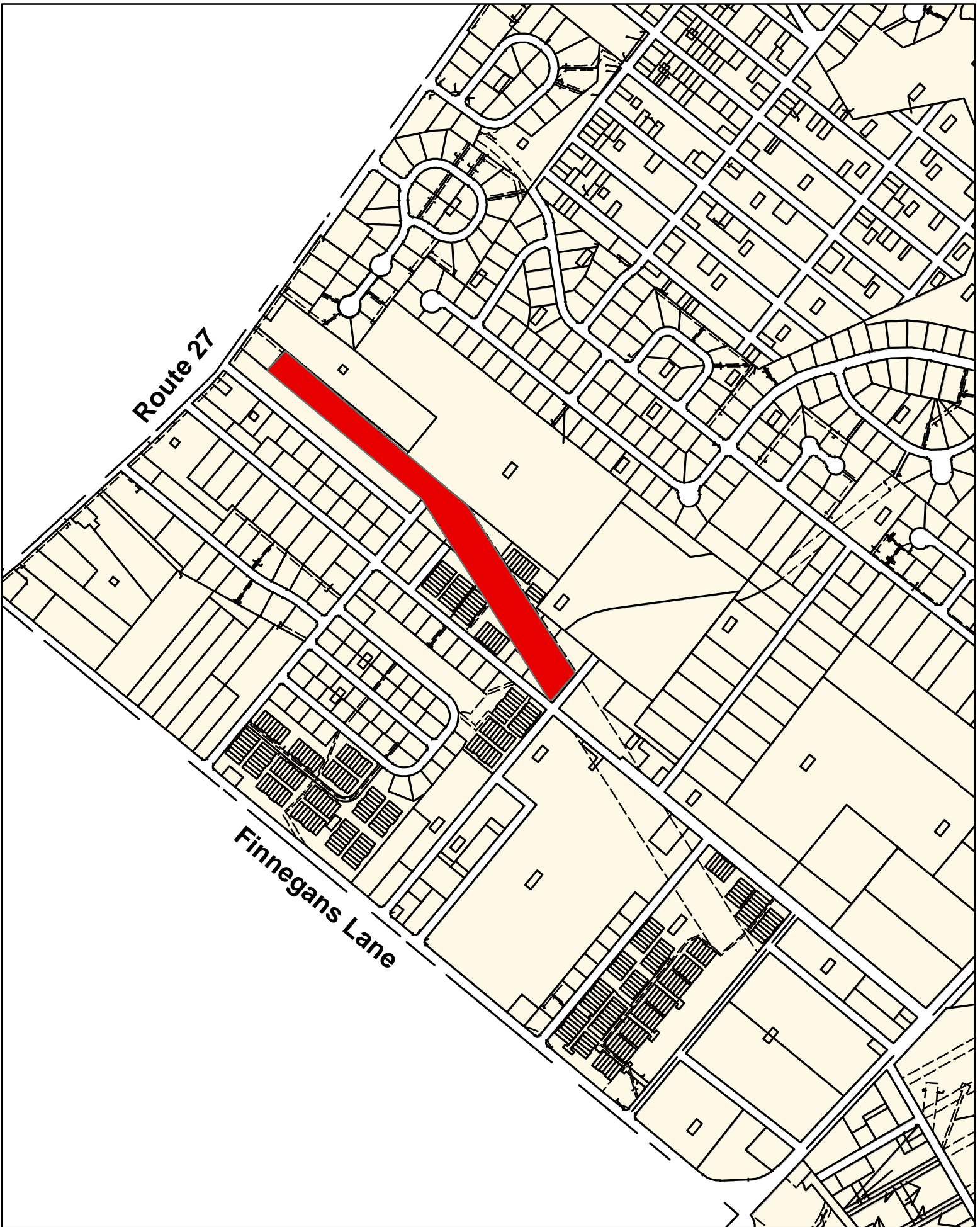
- the continued safety of homeowners living near the transmission lines,
- the safety of PSE&G employees and contractors working on the transmission lines, and
- the reliability of the electric utility system.

The number and size of overgrown trees and other vegetation on the right-of-way in the areas highlighted on the attached list now require vegetation maintenance. A list of nearest cross streets has been provided. Nelson Tree Service, Inc. a private contractor working for PSE&G, will **REMOVE ALL TREES** and other vegetation within the right-of-way and **SIDE TRIM** all branches overhanging the edge of the electric transmission right of way. This work will begin on or about **October 1, 2009** and continue through April 1, 2010. Representatives of the contractors will notify your municipality and the effected property owners in your community in order to provide more specific dates when crews will be working in your area.
