Please listen to 1450 AM on your radio dial. If you should hear that the North Brunswick School system is closed, our transportation is automatically cancelled.

PLEASE NOTE: We have increased our bus fees. In order to maintain the program, these fees were necessary to continue to provide you with transportation services.

PLEASE BE ON TIME for the bus!!

Types of Transportation:

1. By appointment/Call in Advance:

First Priority is given appointments for medical, dental, lab, x-ray and therapy appointments.

Second Priority is given for appointments such as beauty/barber shops, banking, drug and local department stores.

The fee for these trips is \$5.00 per roundtrip.

PLEASE NOTE: Non-medical appointments are subject to cancellation in cases where a medical priority exists.

2. Pre-Scheduled Transportation:

Food Shopping is scheduled for each Monday. Register by the previous Friday by 3 pm for food shopping at the grocery store closest to your home.

Shopping mall trips are usually the first Friday of each month. Transportation is provided to a shopping mall for non-food shopping. This trip has a maximum of 15 passengers.

The fee for these trips is \$5.00 per roundtrip.

3. Transportation to the Senior Center:

Transportation is provided to Senior Center for a variety of township sponsored activities.

The fee for these trips is \$1.00 per roundtrip.
